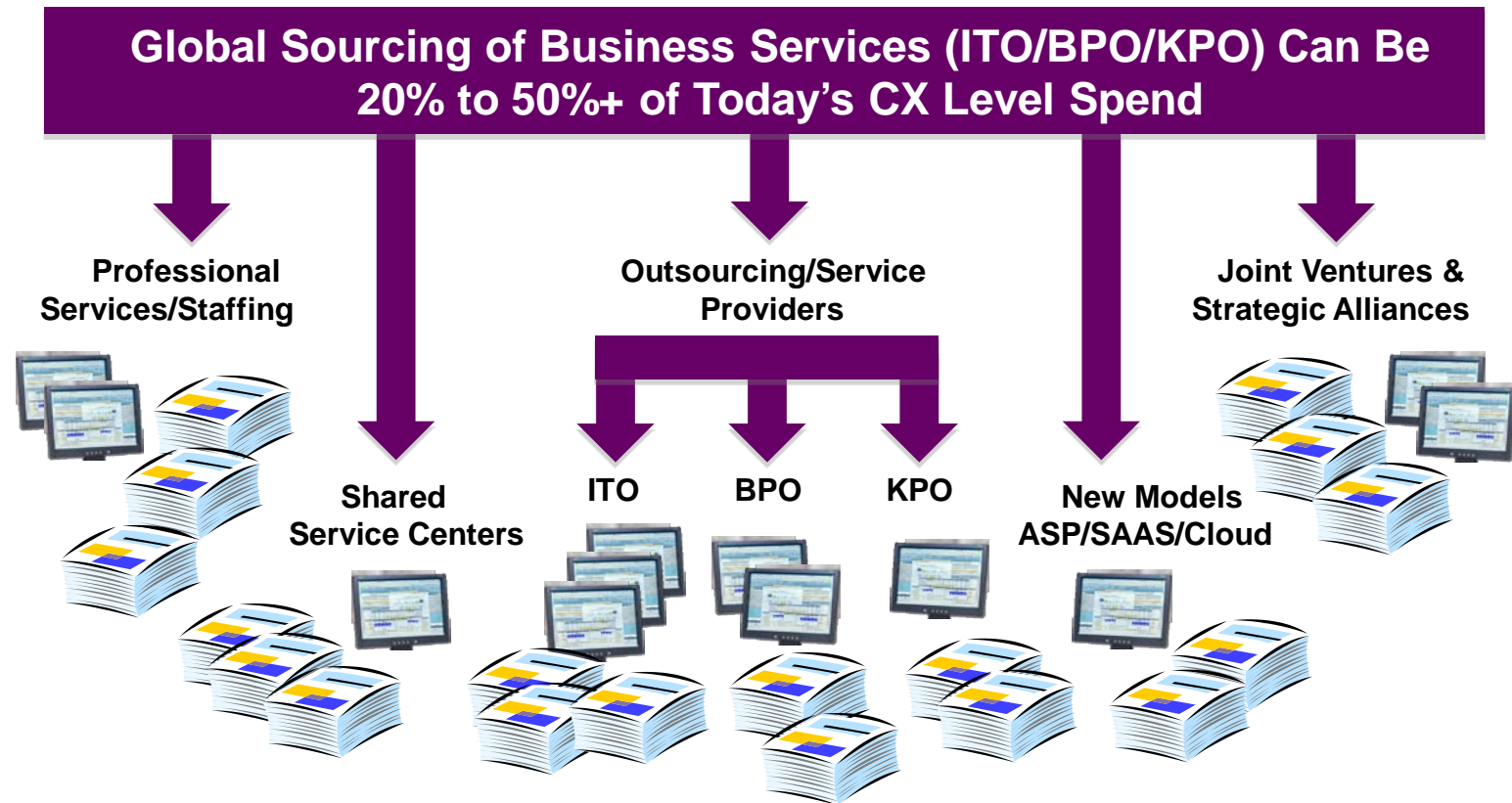
What is the ToolsMAP?

These Global Sourcing Relationships Have Typically Developed As A Series Of One-Off Deals Or Transactions

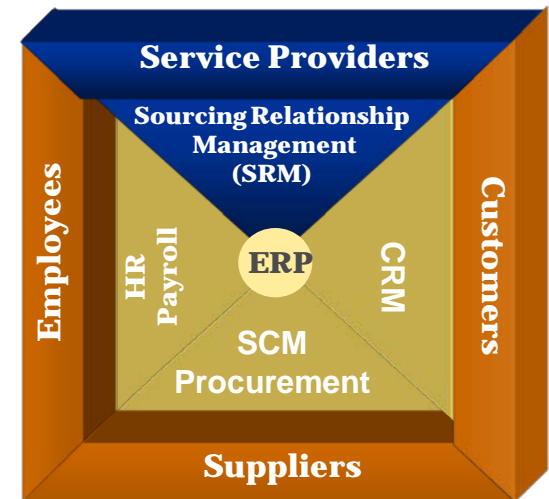

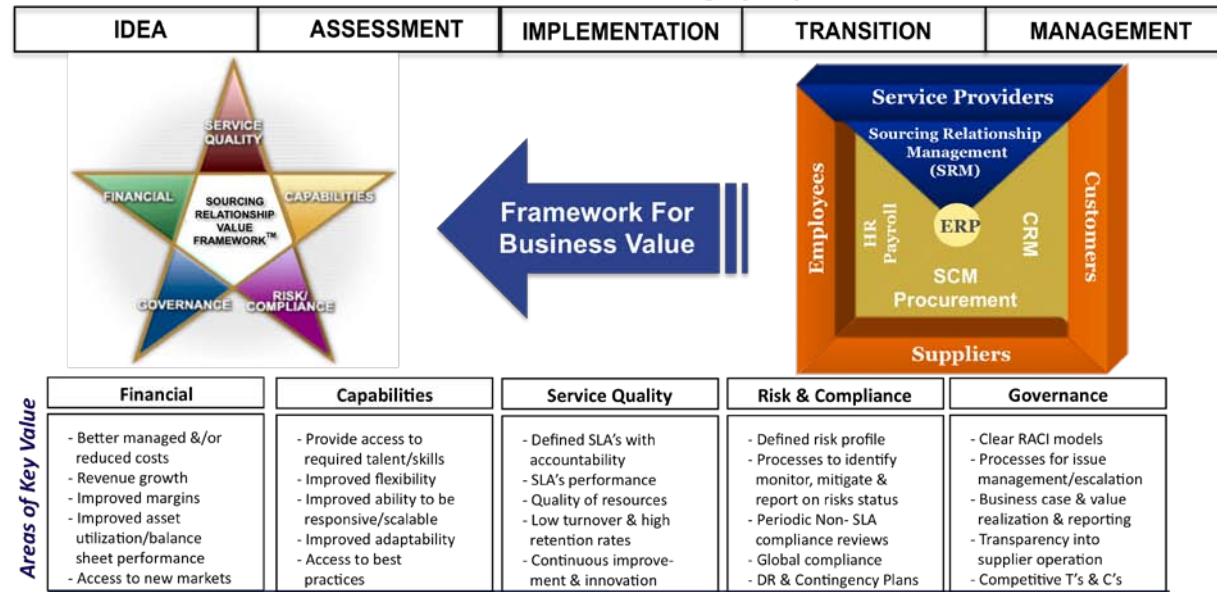

ToolsMAP V2 – Future State



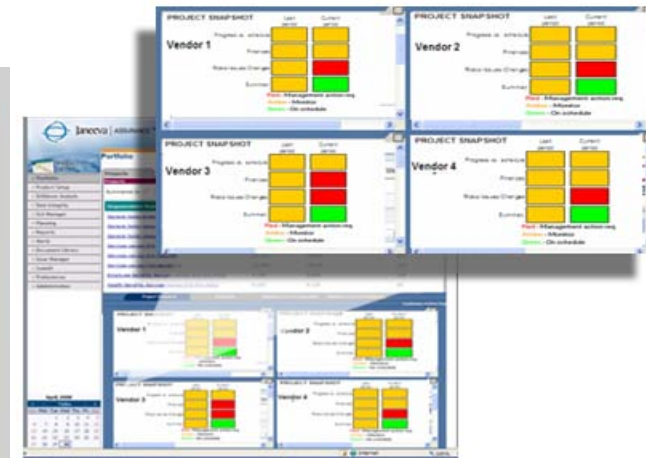
