For nearly a decade, hundreds of companies have voluntarily made a commitment to compete for best of breed, opting in to complete the rigorous process that can be expected when responding to top customers' RFPs.

Their submissions are independently evaluated and ranked by a panel of outsourcing experts and their peers on such criteria as: size and growth, customer experience, depth and breadth of competencies, and management and executive accomplishments.

This is the Global Outsourcing 100 and World's Best Advisors.

"Being on the Global Outsourcing 100 list shows these organizations have a commitment to their customers," says IAOP Chairman Michael Corbett. "They believe in the community of outsourcing professionals, challenging themselves in committing to the continued improvement and growth of the industry."

For the second consecutive year, ISS was named the world's best outsourcing provider and Quint Wellington Redwood topped the list of leading advisors to the industry in the 2014 rankings. Ranked among the top 10 service providers, along with ISS, are, in order: (2) Accenture, (3) CBRE, (4) KellyOCG, (5) Colliers International, (6) HCL Technologies, (7) NCR Services, (8) Pactera (9) Cappemini and (10) CGI.

IAOP started the Global Outsourcing 100 program in 2005 to give the industry an independent resource to help companies compare providers and advisors using an objective methodology. In addition, IAOP produces more than 80 sub-lists by service area, industry served and geography that provide customers of outsourced services with an invaluable tool for selecting the right service provider.

This is the ninth provider list and sixth advisor ranking. Over the past years, the amount of sophistication and details in the applications have grown tremendously, just as can be expected when providers respond to customers' RFP, said Jag Dalal, COP, IAOP Chief Advisor Thought Leadership, chair of the panel.

An analysis of the last seven years showed that while the overall average revenue and employee count has not changed dramatically, the number of global locations for providers has increased significantly, according to Dalal."This clearly shows that outsourcing is a global profession and IAOP's charter helps promote that," he said.

In addition, IAOP also found that providers and advisors are more focused on getting appropriate certifications and, as a result, the COP certification count has gone up dramatically over the same period.

Corbett said of the applicants: "They are investing in Certified Outsourcing Professionals (COPs) — adopting and sharing IAOP's high standards with the rest of the world."

The 2015 Global Outsourcing 100 application process will officially open on Sept. 1, 2014.
